News from Key Stage 2

House Points

The house point system reflects the OneSchool ethos of encouraging a collegiate experience both locally, nationally and globally.

Every student in school is allocated to one of 3 houses, each having their own emblem—



House points are calculated from a number of sources:-

- Achievement points are awarded for demonstrating any of the OneSchool Skills—Leadership, Academic Achievement, Fulfilling Potential, Management Skills and Involvement in School. These can be awarded by any member of staff.
- One house point is awarded for every student that achieves 100% attendance for the week
- One point is awarded for every student that does not accrue any behaviour points during the week
- Points are awarded for the POTW (Player of the week) as detailed on the www.yorkcampussport.co.uk website
- Additional points may be awarded for events such as Sports Day

The weekly totals are then calculated and communicated to students along with a 'Year to date' running total during registration on Friday morning as a part of their weekly student bulletin presented by the Sixth Form students. These figures also feed in to both the national and global OneSchool totals on a weekly basis.
