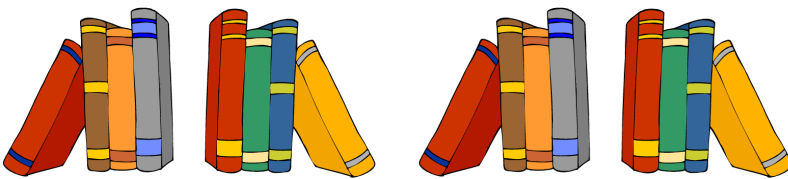
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World Book Day 1st March 2018

All the challenges should be presented neatly, and can be done by hand or on a computer. Try to be as eye-catching and interesting as possible. As usual, check all elements of VSPaG are accurate and appropriately varied.

Design a new front cover for any book.	Write a 100-200 word biography of a famous writer in <i>your own words</i> . Do not copy from the Internet!
Write a 100-200 word blurb or review for/of any book.	Research and write up ten interesting, unusual facts about a writer.
Submit a photo of you reading in an interesting, unusual place!	Design a book mark (20x5cm) (Ideas: purely pictorial; use a well-known quote ...)
Create a story board for any book: 6/8 pictures with captions below.	Make your own reading activity for a peer, based on a favourite book (i.e. True/False, Who said?, gap fill)
